Instructions for Poster Sessions

Abstracts scheduled for poster sessions will be presented in **Zone C, Second Floor** in the Queen Sirikit National Convention Center. There will be nine formal poster-viewing sessions during the congress.

Authors must be at their posters during the designated poster sessions and must be available to answer questions during this time.

- Authors of odd-numbered posters should be present **from 10.45 to 11.15 and from 12.15 to 12.45 on the designated day**
- Authors of even-numbered posters should be present **from 13.00 to 13.30 and from 16.45 to 17.15 on the designated day.**

In the Programme & Abstract book, poster numbers are prefixed with the letter P and suffixed with letters which denote the day of presentation, i.e., TH (Thursday, 4 December), FR (Friday, 5 December), and SA (Saturday, 6 December). (e.g. P305TH means poster number 305, to be presented on Thursday, 4 December). Only the numbers will be posted on the poster boards.

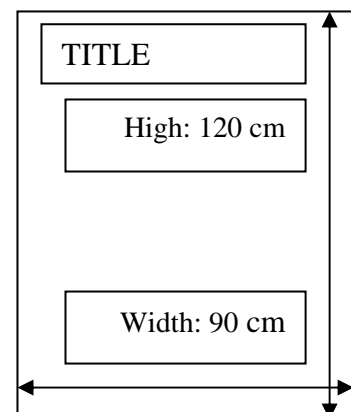
Presenters should put their posters in place during the set up time on the poster boards with the corresponding assigned numbers.

IOF accepts no liability for posters or poster materials and will not adjudicate disputes between abstract presenters

Please note that children 12 years of age and under will not be permitted in the poster area or the exhibit hall at any time.

Printing

- The official poster dimensions are: 90 cm width x 120 cm high
- The posters will be displayed vertically (in a portrait style)



Layout

- The Poster must be readable from a distance of 1 meter (3 feet).
- Each poster must have a label at the top, listing:
 - 1) The title of the paper - characters in the title must be at least 2,5 cm (1 inch) high.
 - 2) The names and affiliations of the presenting author and co-authors.

Rules and Regulations for Poster Boards

- Supply your own double-sided tape to hang up the poster on the boards. A hostess will be at your disposal in case you need help.
- Please note that the use of spray glue, glue, silicone and spray-paint is not permitted. Only double-sided tape is allowed. Also, you cannot write on the poster board or make holes in it.
- *Posters should be removed during the designated hours. If they are not removed during these hours, they will be discarded*
